Joint Local Plan and AONB planning guidance

The immediate priority is to produce consultation responses. Draft material will be built up, circulated and discussed with Peter Sandover at the next Steering Group meeting on 12th August before release. Activities will include:

- Summarising the number of dwellings already built/approved since end-2013 and, with evidencebased rationale, those extra now proposed by reference to the SHELAA. <u>Action MJ</u>
- Compiling an over-arching summary of the key aspects relating to the character of Stoke Fleming as
 a coastal Parish largely situated in the AONB, incorporating the strong community desire to preserve
 the many 'environmental assets': <u>Action: KF</u>
- · Compiling a reasoned position statement regarding renewable energy: Action: MJ
- Producing a statement about employment and enterprise, probably using suitable material from other approved Neighbourhood Plans, but bearing in mind the Parish's relationship with Dartmouth in particular: <u>Action: MJ</u>
- · Other topics identified for coverage include West Dart, affordable housing and broadband.
